Schaefer's business focuses on facilitating an environment where people can learn to sew or sharpen their skills as a seamstress. With the help of Kiva Zip, she can jump-start her business and start offering classes.



Another bright entrepreneur benefiting

from the new crowd-sourced funding is Kelly Everson of Rock Paper Scissors, a shop that sells handmade and repurposed artwork. With the help of Kiva Zip, Everson met her \$7,500 goal in less than one week as well. Everson is now preparing for her grand opening on April 17 at Milwaukee and Mason streets.

To date, Kiva Zip has helped raise more than \$71,000 for 11 different Milwaukee area entrepreneurs.
